





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













Boughton Park - Proposed Parking Lot

Alternates - Phase 1























Alternates - Phase 2








Prefabricated Bridge





RE: Permission To Use Resident's Property For East Bloomfield Nature Trail

Dear Residents and Property Owners:

Our team from Flower City Engineers are here to inform you that the Town of East Bloomfield has requested to design a recreational trail that runs from one end of town to the other. Our design for the Town of East Bloomfield Recreational Trails may potentially cross within property and we ask for your permission to build our proposed trail over your property.

The recreational nature trial(s) project are broken into two phases:

- Phase 1 consists of building a parking lot and information kiosk over part of the
 existing corn field and east of the existing Boughton Park parking lot off of Boughton
 Rd. The trails will begin Southeast of Boughton Park and run south into the Village of
 East Bloomfield.
- Phase 2 consists of continuing the trail from the Village of East Bloomfield and into Veterans Park. Additional information kiosks will be placed accordingly. Refer to the proposed trail outline marked in red attached below.

The trials widths and composites are still under consideration but we propose a typical 8 foot wide trial consisting of asphalt and/or stone dust material and these trials will be maintained by the Town of East Bloomfield Trial Volunteers.


These trails will be accessible for those interested in tiking, jogging, bicycling, cross county running and sking. No Motorized Vehicles are permitted on these trails. These trials will allow town residents and visitors to stay healthy, active and access to the village: supporting the local businesses and providing funding for developing future town projects.

The project will continue with its construction at the start of March 2022.

Town of East Bloomfield - Nature Trail Project

The Town of East Bioomfield Supervisor Fred Wille and Town Board Members, are looking to expand on the existing nature trails in Boughton Park. The scope of work is to complete a full

scale, 10' wide trait, ranging from Boughton Park to Veterno's Park. In the Village of East Bloomfield the trait will range a total of 4.05 miles, but will be broken down into two phases, Phase 1 & Phase 2 Phase 1 will consist of the trail starting at Boughton Park, where a proposed parking lot is recommended, and travels down to the center of the village (4 corners). Phase 2 will pick up at the center of the village (4 corners), and end at Veterans Park. This trail will utilize an existing abandoned trail which will out down on costs and schedule. Not only will the scope of this



project consist of new nature trails, but it will also allow access to the existing trails at Boughton Park, and the new trails through the proposed parking lot.

The Town of East Bloomfield nature trails are going to be bid as a two Phase project. The bid process on Phase 1 will take 4 months. The start date of Phase 1 construction will begin on April 3, 2023. The total construction time on Phase 1 will be completed in 5 months. Funding and grants for Phase 2 will be completed by January 15, 2024. The Total construction time of Phase 2 will be 3 months and the scope of work is for less extensive.

The Town of East Bloomfield nature trail cost for both Phase 1 & 2 is \$1,127,859. The Town will be applying for funding and grants to help mitigate the cost of the project. The grant will be maxed at \$500,000, which will reduce the amount of the project cost, it then comes to cost around \$427,859. There will be some options for bonds for the Town of East Bloomfield, the first with an interest rate of 2.0% for 10 years and the second at 5.0% for 25 years. The values for the estimated tax rates for the respective bond options are 0.2275 for (2% for 10 years) and 0.1450 for (5% for 25 years). The cost of an average home will be \$38 (2% for 10 years) and \$24 (5% for 25 years).



The Town of East Bloomfield Nature Trail

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Town of East Bloomfield's goal is to connect Boughton Park to the four corners then to veterans park. This trail will help boost the town economy by allowing an easy route to the town center. Additionally, connecting to Boughton park allows connection to the existing trails there. The scope of work is to complete a 10' wide trail starting from Boughton Park to Veterans Park. This trail will be approximately 4 miles long, but will be broken down into two phases. Phase 1 will consist of the trail starting at Boughton Park, where a proposed parking lot is recommended, and travel down into the Village of East bloomfield (aka 4 Corners). Phase 2 will pick up at from the village (4 Corners), and end at Veterans Park. This trail will utilize an existing abandoned railroad bed which will cut down on costs and schedule. Not only will the scope of this project consist of new nature trails, but it will also allow access to the existing trails at Boughton Park, and the new trails through the proposed parking lot.

The trail will cross into some residents' property but the vast majority of the trail will be within the easements obtained by the town and on the existing railroad bed.




Financial Analysis
