

VETERANS PARK/ELTON PARK

BOUGHTON PARK

To use Boughton Park, you are required to have a Boughton Park Vehicle Tag. Vehicle Tags for East Bloomfield residents are available at the East Bloomfield Town Clerk's Office. You must provide a valid NYS Driver's License and Vehicle Registration.

RECYCLE MEDICATIONS

DOG LICENSES - annually
