The Board continued discussion on newly proposed fowl regulations provided by Woodruff. Some topics discussed are as follows:

- Number of chicks/animals vs size of parcel
- Animals for slaughter
- Requirements for obtaining a building permit for a chicken coup, a discussion of a \$20.00 fee for coups under fifty (50) sq ft. All others would be considered accessory structures
- How to structure the code with or without guidelines for fowl
- Free range chickens and the need to keep them on your property, Compton stated that if you have five (5) acres or more free ranging could be allowed Lester stated that on less than five (acres) free ranging should not be allowed
- Peacocks should not be allowed on less than five (5) acres
- Meat birds

Woodruff will modify the proposed regulations and forward to Rayburn for dispersal.
