East Bloomfield Summer Recreation FAQ

UPK-7 Program

Children entering UPK through Seventh grade will have a busy summer of fun activities! They will be assigned to groups according to the *grade they will be entering* in the fall with dedicated and attentive counselors and volunteers! Regular activity stations will include athletics, music, art, science, playground and much more. In addition, special events will occur throughout camp and theme days. All activities are well planned and supervised, with a program wide focus on teambuilding and cooperative fun! Incoming sixth and seventh graders have the opportunity to do a little of everything. They will attend some stations while at the same time have independent activities all to themselves.

Transportation

Students must be transported to camp (Veterans Park) by a parent/guardian. All parents/caregivers will follow the signage to their campers specific drop off location inside the Rec building. Pick up will be the same way with a photo ID required when picking up campers until counselors are familiar with who is authorized to pick up each camper. Failure to follow all drop off and pick up procedures will result in your camper's suspension from camp. Campers should not be dropped off in front of the building. Please park and walk your child to the building.

Directors & Camp Medical Staff

Returning for their second year, Amy Culbertson will be the Director and Kelly Ulmer will be the Assistant Director. We will also have a certified medical professional on site. Any questions or concerns about camp operation, staff & volunteer or camper issues should be brought to the attention of either the Director or Assistant Director. All medical questions should go to the medical professional. No medicine will be distributed without specific written instructions from a physician.

<u>Volunteers</u>

Those students entering 8th grade will have the opportunity to volunteer. Volunteer applications will be available at registration night, the town hall and M.S. & H.S. offices. Volunteering for camp is the best way to earn a paid position once you are 16 or entering your junior year. Volunteering does not guarantee you a position.

Program Trip - Beach Day at Onanda Park Thursday, August 1, 2024 9am till 3:30pm

This year we will be offering **one free full day trip** to Onanda Park. This will be a fun day of recreational swimming, outdoor play, nature activities and beach games. The kids will have time to use the full facilities and to eat lunch there as well. For the whole day outing, campers should bring a bagged lunch, swim gear and towel, water bottle, and even some extra snacks. Pick up time for this day will be at 3:30 pm at Veterans Park. There will be no additional cost for this trip; however, there will be <u>no half day program at camp on this day</u>. If for any reason your child does not attend the field trip, they will not attend camp that day.

Program T-Shirts

Program t-shirts will be provided for all campers in our morning camp program. For safety issues, children must wear these on **field trips** and other **special offsite days**. This will help make our group easily identifiable.


