# SHORT TERM AND LONG-TERM PROJECTS

## WATER FEASIBILITY STUDY.

East Bloomfield authorized this important and timely study. It was conducted and completed by Chatfield Engineers by JP Schepp & Paul Chatfield. This study maps out the entire town, property by property, with graphics and geographic elevations along with estimated costs per household unit for running water. The town was divided into geographic regions for better understanding. Two areas have begun further study. Those areas are McCann Road and Pond/Rice/Steele, and NYS Route 444. The onset of the Pandemic has delayed progress by more than a year.

#### VETERANS PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

- Renovation of American Legion Building.
- Expansion of parking lot with new paving and striping.
- Installation of regulation size full court for basketball.
- Erection of new playground.
- Improved maintenance to softball and baseball diamonds.
- Planted two sets of trees from Cornell university & Northern Nursery.
- Development of a walking path.
- Installation of new septic system with enlarged capacity.
- Increase signage for vehicle parking & dog walkers.
- Approve two Eagle Scout Projects for benches & tables.
- Upgraded field conditions via Highway Department.
- Upgraded maintenance and site improvement via Highway Department.
- Upgrade overall security.

#### FLTON PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

- Increased attention to tree maintenance.
- Increased harvesting and removal of limbs and entire trees with disease.
- Upgrades to gazebo.
- Extensive upgrades and improvements to archway structure.
- Landscaped the archway with extensive removal and replacement.

#### **BOUGHTON PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.**

- Work closely with Boughton Park Commission on a range of issues.
- Recently appointed Christian Culbertson to the BP Commission.
- Established a new work group to study ponds & dams at BP/Victor/W. Bloomfield.
- Increase road signage to prohibit roadside parking as safety & nuisance measure.
- Strengthened our involvement in maintenance /upgrades via Highway Department
- Highway Department built the housing for two new outdoor commodes.
- Invite periodic presentations from BPC president Dave Damaske to Town Board.

- Completion of technology audit by Ontario County IT Department.
- Installation of a new telecommunications system as well as new WIFI System.
